Old Manse Update

The building contractor has taken down most of the scaffolding, except at the front where it is still needed for leadwork to finish off at the bay roofs. Work has been ongoing internally with the insulating of the attics and re-plastering to some of the rooms. The heating system has been turned back on to help with the drying, which will take some time due to the thick solid walls.
